ABOUT THE EVENT

Steps for Life - Walking for Families of Workplace Tragedy is Threads of Life's main fundraiser. Since 2005, Steps for Life has raised \$9.4 million for support programs and services for families affected by a workplace tragedy, as well as increased health and safety awareness in each community it touches. The funds raised provide much-needed services for individuals and families affected by a workplace injury, disease, or fatality. In 2025, Canada saw 30 communities unite in parks and virtual events, collecting close to \$1,200,000 in the Steps for Life effort.



Over the month of May

Steps for Life events kickoff the first weekend of May annually, and are hosted in communities throughout the month.



Across Canada

Steps for Life walk events are held in communities from east to west - in parks, at home and even virtually with the National Online event.

Steps for Life Impact:

Janesse's cousin Christopher died while working in road construction when he was struck by an asphalt roller. Janesse says: "Steps for Life gives families and communities the opportunity to honour our loved ones and raise awareness around the



importance of health and safety. My goal now is to help others with their struggles and let them know that we are not alone, and someone is always here to help. By working together, we can end workplace tragedies and save lives that should never have been lost or altered in the first place."

Where does the money go?

The funds raised through Steps for Life help pay for the programs Threads of Life offers for people affected by work-related tragedy: inperson gatherings, online webinars, volunteer training, outreach and prevention efforts. Because of your contributions, more people will find healthy ways to cope with the effects of a lifealtering injury, illness or workplace death, and more workplaces will take steps to prevent future tragedies.

Threads of Life is accredited through the Imagine Canada Standards program. Accredited charities and nonprofits have completed a rigorous independent peer review of their operating and governance practices. We post our annual reports and financial statements publicly on our website.




Steps to Become a Sponsor:
